Dear Parents,

On behalf of all the staff at St Patrick's I would like to thank you for your generous Christmas wishes, cards and presents which were very much appreciated.

Last Sunday we celebrated the feast of the Epiphany, closely followed by the feast of the Baptism of the Lord which, this year, marked the end of the Church's Christmas Season.

"Epiphany" means "appearance" or "revelation" and in the gospel stories of Epiphany we hear God appearing in creation: God is revealed in a star, in the waters of the river, in the shining skies, on the wings of a dove.
