Dear Parents,

In the Christian calendar the year has several forty day periods; all of them, in some way, connected to the idea of renewal. During the summer comes the "quarantine" (a word meaning forty days) between the feast of the Transfiguration on 6th August and the Holy Cross on 14th September. The dating of these two feasts reflects on ancient legend, founded on the biblical imagery of the number forty, that the transfiguration of the Lord took place forty days before the crucifixion. It is in the context of these forty days that we rest, relax and renew our energy before the beginning of the new school year.

To celebrate the end of their time at St Patrick's year 6 wrote, produced and performed a world war 2 extravaganza "We'll meet again." They must all be congratulated on the outstanding quality of every performance.
